**"The Government issued Executive Order No. 614/2025 and confirmed an extra 4-day weekend."**

The Executive has confirmed the new calendar until December after announcing its decision to promote domestic tourism and reorganize movable public holidays.

According to EO No. 614/2025, a key change was introduced to the national public holiday calendar just a few weeks ago. This opened the door to another extra-long weekend in November. This announcement means that the public holiday Argentina's National Sovereignty Day, which is celebrated on November 20th every year, has now been moved to Monday, November 24th, adding a non-working day Friday, November 21st to the calendar for tourism purposes.

As a result of this change, the calendar of national holidays for 2025 will be as follows:

Friday, October 10 - Sunday, October 12: a long weekend to celebrate the Day of Respect for Cultural Diversity. The national holiday that falls on Sunday, October 12 has now been moved to Friday, November 10.

Friday, November 21 - Monday, November 24: an extra-long weekend for Argentina's National Sovereignty Day, which is celebrated on November 24 every year.

Saturday, December 6 - Monday, December 8: The Immaculate Conception of the Blessed Virgin Mary is celebrated on December 8 and cannot be moved.
